

# DEPARTMENT 13 VEGETABLES

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## SECTION 1 - VEGETABLES

1. The exhibit must be grown or produced in Carbon County or West Penn Township, Schuylkill County.
2. The fair will provide plates/trays for display.
3. All vegetables must be clean, uniform in size and must contain number of specimens called for on list. **NOTE: please pay attention to number of specimens required for each item.**
4. Potatoes should be gently washed, remove all soil using a soft cloth or brush.
5. Tomatoes should have stems removed.
6. Carrots, beets, etc. should have tops removed from vegetable leaving about two inches of stem.
7. The following factors will be used for judging: trueness to variety, uniformity of shape, size, and color. Select specimens that are perfect and show no blemishes of any kind. Make sure specimens are of high quality.

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### SECTION 2 – HERBS

1. Specimen and Container shall be clean (removing insect damaged foliage, dead or faded blooms/leaves)
2. Correct identification on entry tag is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
3. All entries must be grown by exhibitor
4. Judging shall be on the basis of quality. Judges will consider condition and presentation.
5. Fragrance and/or flavor characteristic of herb shall be important factors.

#### FRESH GREEN HERBS

- Three stems uniform in size and conformation.
- Submitted in water in clear container suited to size of specimen.

Remove leaves below water level.

- Herbs may be shown with leaves and flowers and/or fresh seeds.
