 EXHIBITS1. The use of or displaying artificial flowers and or foliage is prohibited unless specified in the schedule.
2. All entries must be grown by exhibitor in Carbon County or West Penn Township, Schuylkill County, except those in arrangement classes.
3. No wired stems will be accepted.
4. All specimen flower entries must be n clear containers, (NO COLORED GLASS). Artistic arrangements should be in containers which are in harmony with the arrangement. Tin Cans or unsightly containers will not be allowed. Maximum care will be taken of the containers until they are removed by exhibitors.
5. Pots for houseplants (standard cannot exceed 15 " across top of pot.
6. All plants must be grown in exhibiting container at least 90 days prior to entering at fair
7. No artificial arrangements will be accepted.
8. All plants must be insect and disease free.
9. All materials need to be in prime condition and healthy. Plants should be well-groomed and clean, showing NO dead parts or signs of insect damage. No artificial preparation to shine plant leaves.
10. Pots must be clean and have no cracks. No accessory in pots (unless otherwise stated).
11. Professionals may not enter the artistic class, except as specified.
12. An exhibitor, if he chooses, may replace a specimen after the judging is complete to "freshen" a display

## Suggestions to Exhibitors

- Specimen flowers should be at their prime with plant material as nearly perfect as possible. Uniformity of height, color, and size help to win a premium
- All top-heavy entries must be in a clear container that will not upset. Clear marbles can be used to help stabilize.
- All debris, spray residue, insects, spent flowers, old fruit or berries, and Injured foliage should be removed before entering.
- Endeavor to use plenty of foliage of flowers themselves.
- Where specific measurements are required, BE SURE TO MEASURE ACCURATELY.

## SECTION 8 - ARTISTIC ARRANGEMENTS (TABLE)

Flower arranging is the art of organizing elements according to principles of design to attain beauty, harmony, distinction, and expression. The container and plant should have in common: size, color and shape, and be in proportion to each other. The mechanics, oasis, pin holder, etc. should be concealed, not distracting. Some hints for standard design:

1. Material used need not be grown by the exhibitor.
. All fresh material to be used unless otherwise stated.
2. Preserved (glycerinized), skeletonized, or bleached plant material are considered as treated plant material. All are not permitted in all classes.
3. Plant material that has been trimmed, stripped, edged, peeled, split, or punched with holes, changed in shape by cutting, bending, twisting, breaking for the purpose of designing is permitted.
4. Ribbons, bows or accessories are not permitted, unless otherwise stated.
5. Gray bases or mats are permitted in all classes.
6. Arrangements are not to exceed 32 " high by $26^{\prime \prime}$ wide, unless otherwise stated.
