#### **SECTION 2 – HAY**

Exhibit Shall consist of a bale section 8" - 12" thick, must be Tied

- CLASS 101 Alfalfa grass mixed 1st cutting, from 10% to 50% of grasses
  - 102 Alfalfa grass mixed later cuttings, from 10% to 50% of grasses
  - 103 Other legumes or legume mixtures not over 50% of grasses
  - 104 Grass 2<sup>nd</sup> cutting, mixtures or timothy and/or other grasses & containing not more than 10% of legumes
- 107 Summer, annual grasses, Sudan grass, Sorghum, Sudan, Hybrids 108 Alfalfa 1st cutting not over 10% of grasses
- 109 Alfalfa later cutting, not over 10% of grasses
- 110 Clover with not over 20% of timothy or other grasses
- 111 Clover timothy mixed, a mixture of clover and timothy
- 105 Grass 2<sup>nd</sup> cutting, mixtures of timothy and/or other grasses & containing not more than 10% legumes
- 106 Mixed Hay any mix not classified in previous classes but contains 50% or more singly or in combo of alfalfa, timothy, clover and grasses

### **SECTION 4 – SILAGE**

Silage crop must be named. Silage is to be exhibited in one (1) gallon clear plastic bag CLASS

  - 201 Perennial crops direct cut, (green chop)
  - 202 Perennial crops wilted or low moisutre, with or without preservatives
  - 301 High moisture ground ear corn
  - 302 High moisture ground shelled corn400 Corn Silage
